ELIGIBILITY

1. Projects must use a significant amount of concrete or concrete products. (Any product specified as CSI Div.3, Div. 042200 or 047200)
2. The sustainable building practice does not have to involve concrete or concrete products. (Ex: re-using materials for forms; fuel efficient materials delivery, etc.)
3. Projects must have some type of green certification or verification, documenting the environmentally-friendly products and practices used.
4. Projects must be completed before January 1, 2009.
5. There is no geographical restriction—projects can be anywhere in the world.

RECOGNITION OF WINNERS

Winners will be recognized with special articles in both CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION and THE CONCRETE PRODUCER, and on our web sites. Winning projects will also be featured in the GREENSITE exhibit at World of Concrete.
